Youth Villages – Educational program

« Youth Villages » will be taking place on Pôle 2

Sport is benefit space for citizen apprenticeship, tolerance and living together.

FISEC games represent a time dedicated to high-level sport practice, **but also an educational lever.**

Formalize educational actions on the following themes :

- Fight against any kind of violence, discrimination and doping
- First-aid awareness
- Shape test
- Developing body aptitudes
- Inclusion : CAPSAAA intervention : wheelchair Rugby
- Silkscreen printing workshop
- Forum exchanges and reflections
- E-sport discovery (e-ping)



Additional Cultural programs

A partnership with Dunkerque office tourism for discoveries tours (of the city):

The « Dynamo Tour »:

During the tour, your guide will make you relive the « Dynamo Operation ». Details of this evacuation, as well as its causes and consequences.

This visit will take you to see « la Jetée Est », the British Memorial, the rebuild downtown, Little Ship Princess Elizabeth, and « L'Evacuation » beaches.

The discovery of the port on board the « Texel »

Dunkerque harbour, whose impressive installations cover half of the coastline of the North department, can be discovered along the waterside on the boat « Texel ».

The Sugar Hall :

Inside the walls of a former port warehouse, the Sugar Hall is a center of resources and expertise on the theme of the sustainable city.



An innovative project in favour of inclusion

UGSEL allows people with and without a disability to share physical and sports activities **together**.

In this way, the concept of inclusion takes on its full meaning in the educational values promoted by our federation, under the heading of the integral development of the person.

It is therefore a question of promoting inclusive sport through the implementation of proposals, favouring the mix of people such as:

- **A Rugby demonstration by a professional team CAP SAAA**
- **A time of practice together with young people from different nations**



Welcome, accompany, guide

Reception and accompaniment are UGSEL's values of the educational project, which's fit in the Catholic spirit of the FISEC.

Each delegation will be able to benefit from escorts and guides allowing them to live this week of games in comfortable conditions.

We propose to set up brigades of interpreter guides (high school students, students, former participants of the FISEC) in connection with the high schools and universities of Dunkerque and other partners.



Emergency services

- **Emergency station:** « croix rouge », civil protection.

UGSEL is involved in first aid training and responds to educational issues.

Implementation of :

- **Brigades, young rescues workers UGSEL**
- **Incumbent people of PSC1 or/and PSC1 trainer**
- **Help from local physiotherapy or paramedical schools**



Communication tools :

- Signage (logo with a slogan and signage system (sport, info, directions,...)).
- 1 team of young reporters to cover in live sports competitions and events, retrieve the results of the day, interview the players, referees for a « TV news ». Linked with the newsletter.
- Use of a drone for competitions, the cultural course, the Youth village, CIRPP events, etc...
- 1 team for the report, managing the website (results,...) in live.
- A cloud for the documents and photos for each nation's.
- 1 communication team in relation with the local and national press, politics, territorial communities, state (MEN, MJS, CNOSF), diplomacy.
